

STRONGARBH HOUSE ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT

There is a regular bus service which runs around the island, including between the ferries at Craignure and Fishnish and Tobermory.

CATCHING THE BUS

Buses generally meet the ferries, although not every ferry has a connecting bus so it is worth checking timetables before you decide on a ferry time. From May to October there are connections for most ferries.

Buses leave Craignure from the end of the main walkway and are very easy to find when you leave the ferry. Buses from Fishnish arrive at the ferry slipway at the scheduled time.

The timetable for this bus service can be found at www.bowmanstours.co.uk - do check the small print on the timetable to ensure that you don't get stranded! Buses cost around £7 per person,



ARRIVING BY BUS

The bus takes approximately 50 mins to get to Tobermory from Craignure. When you arrive in Tobermory there are two possible stops.

Stop One

The first, and the nearest to Strongarbh House, is VICTORIA STREET. The stop is along a windy road in upper tobermory, past the fire station on the left and just beyond a small art gallery, which is painted bright blue.

When you alight from the bus walk down Victoria Street towards the sea. At the church turn left and follow the road as it bends around to the right with An Tobar, the arts centre, on your left (follow the road, not the steep hill with a no through road sign!). There is no pavement here so be careful of cars as you round the corner!

About 100 yards down the hill, you will see a gate with Strongarbh House on it. Go through the gate, up the path and through the garden to reach the house, do take care as it is a little steep!

Stop Two

The second stop you can get off at is the final stop and will drop you right in town near the visitor centre at LEDAIG CARPARK. To reach Strongarbh House from there follow Main Street right around the bay past most of the shops. At the red book shop (Tackle and Books) turn right up the hill. Pass the sharp turning on the right and you will see the gate with Strongarbh House just around the bend. Follow the path up through the garden to reach the house.



TAXIS

There are three taxi services running in Tobermory and most of these will be happy to collect you from the ferry or bring you to the house from the Main Street. We recommend using Alan Robson, who can be contacted on 07760 426351 or find him at www.mulltaxi.co.uk.
